1. Purpose of personal data processing and legal basis for processing

The purpose of the personal data processing is: investigation of complaints (notifications) of data subjects, who have made the complaint or are being investigated on the basis of a complaint.

Personal data are processed: pursuant to Act No. 54/2019 Coll. on Certain Measures Related to the Reporting of Anti-social Activities and on the amendment of certain Acts

The legitimate interest of the Controller or third party

The processing of personal data for a purpose of the legitimate interests of the Controller or third party does not apply.

2. Identification of processed personal data of the data subjects

Data subjects, whose personal data are processed are: natural persons who have made the complaint and persons who are being investigated

The extent of processed personal data: title, name, surname, date of birth and permanent address, residence address and other data necessary to verify the complaint

3. Identification of recipients, categories of recipients

Information about the processing of personal data

The Controller may provide personal data to the authorized entities, such as institutions and organizations, under a specific legal regulation or to the contractors (especially the data Processors) who have undertaken to accept reasonable safeguards for the protection of the processed personal data, as follows:

Personal data may be provided to other recipients if the data subject consents or orders to provide his/her personal data to them.

4. Transfer of personal data to third county/ international organization

Transfer of personal data to third countries or international organizations does not apply.

5. Identification of the source of which the data were collected

Directly from the data subject (in person, in the mailbox, by email, by phone, via the Controller's website)

6. The retention period of personal data

The Controller shall process the personal data for the period necessary to fulfill the purpose, but maximum of 3 years.

7. Profiling

The Controller does not process the personal data by profiling, or by other similar means based on automated individual decision-making.

8. Rights of the data subject

The data subject shall have the right to request from the Controller the access to processed personal data concerning him/her, the right to rectification of personal data, the right to personal data erasure or restriction, the right to object to the

processing of personal data, the right not to be subject to a decision based solely on automated processing, including profiling, the right to data portability as well as the right to initiate the proceeding to supervisory authority. When the Controller processes the personal data based on data subject's consent, the data subject shall have the right to withdraw his or her consent to processing at any time. The withdrawal of consent shall not affect the lawfulness of processing based on consent before its withdrawal. The data subject can exercise his/her rights by sending the letter to the address of the Controller.

9. Obligation to provide personal data

The data subject provides his/ her personal data on the voluntary basis, in accordance with the law, if the data subject refuses to provide personal data, it will not be possible to report the outcome of the inquiry / investigation to data subject or to contact data subject for additional information if necessary.
